The AutoCount Activity Stream module is a powerful tool designed to provide a comprehensive activity log capturing all user actions related to transaction entries within the AutoCount accounting software. This module serves as a centralized repository that records activities such as Create New, Edit, Delete, View, Preview, Print, and Open Print Listing Report. By logging these actions, the Activity Stream module enhances transparency, accountability, and security while enabling efficient auditing and analysis of user interactions.

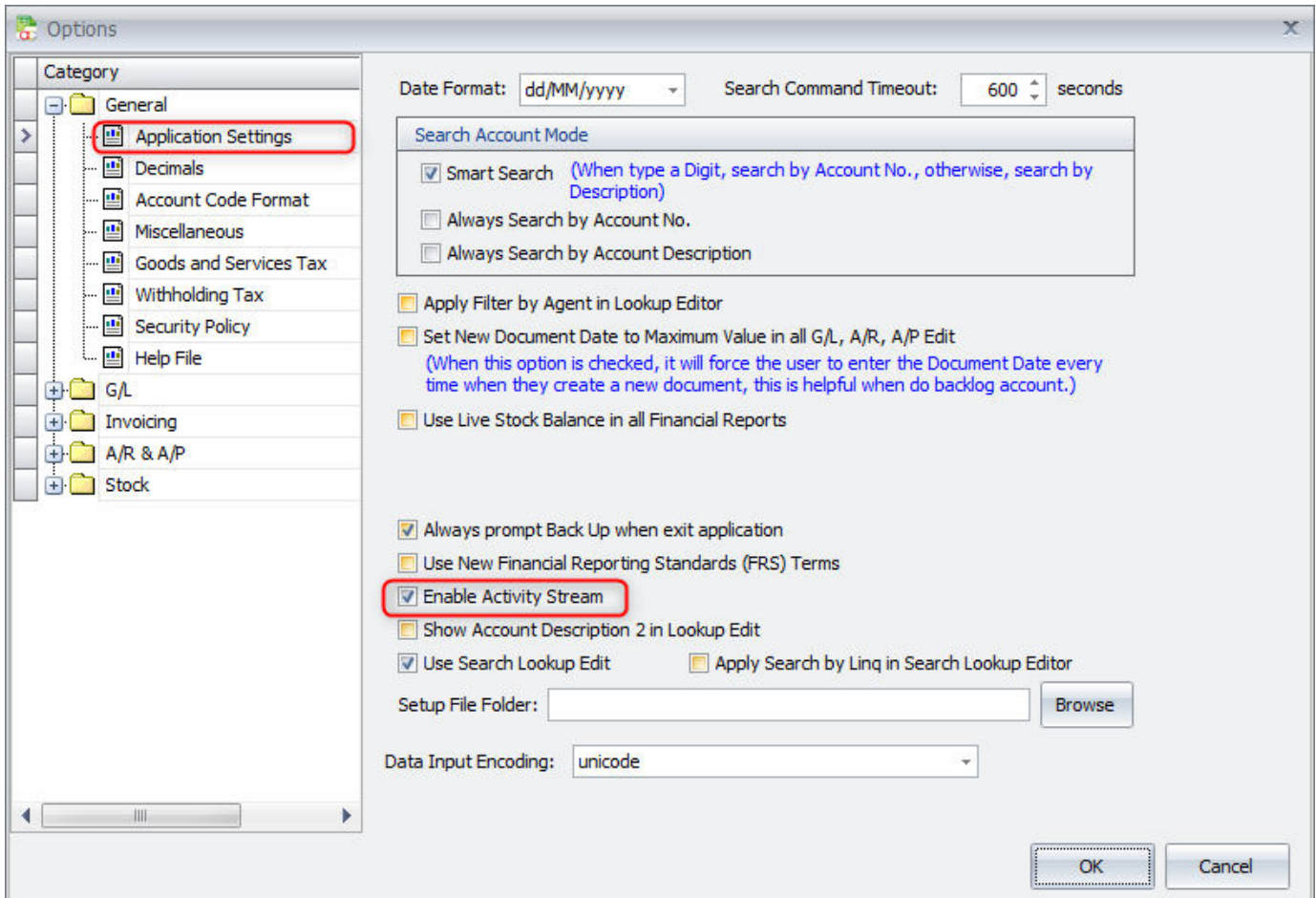

2.0 Settings

2.1 Activate the Option

Go to *Tools > Options > General > Application Settings*



Check the checkbox of **Enable Activity Stream** and relog into AutoCount, this will activate the recording log to record all activities carried out by all users related to transaction entries, such as Create New, Edit, Delete, View, Preview, Print, Open Print Listing Report.

3.0 Features

3.1 Assign Access Rights

1. Go to **General Maintenance > Access Right Maintenance**
2. Look into **Tools > Activity Stream**
3. Assign access rights to related users/group.
